

New Evidence on Burial Practices in Petrești Culture

The aim of the current paper is to present two inhumation graves belonging to Petrești culture recently discovered within the Petrești-Groapa Galbenă settlement (Alba County, Transylvania). The burial of a deceased in a cist made of adobe pieces represents an unusual funerary practice for the Eneolithic Petrești culture communities. This discovery is especially important because the current state of research related to the mortuary practices of Petrești culture bearers is not satisfactory.
